- Online app at www.dsacommunityfoundation.com > Receive > Scholarships > How to Apply
- Eligibility Tool – If you see a scholarship above that you think you're eligible for, but it doesn't appear on the portal, ASK!!
- **Deadline is January 15th at 11:59pm!**

Recommendations

Request them soon - verbally & via online portal! You must start app and do electronic request so writer has something to respond to.

Financial Need Scholarships

- DSACF scholarships require the Student Aid Report from the FAFSA
- FAFSA = Free Application for Federal Student Aid (Don't pay!)
- FAFSA is tough – kind of like doing your taxes; start early!

Best Foot Forward!

- Always very competitive.
- Remember it's not **you** that will win the scholarship; it's your **application**.
- Do a great job! – writing, spelling, small i's, complete lists...
- Get someone to check over your application, several times!!
